













### The Nexus: increasing (need of) resources and risks














### Open and Big Data





Sensors (satellites, drones, webcams ..) are here to stay and grow Smartphones and mobile devices are transforming the way we work and communicate













# Big Data and Citizens

From Benedict XVI (2005) to Pope Francis (2013): citizens become "human sensors", produce and receive information














## Big Data and Citizen science




